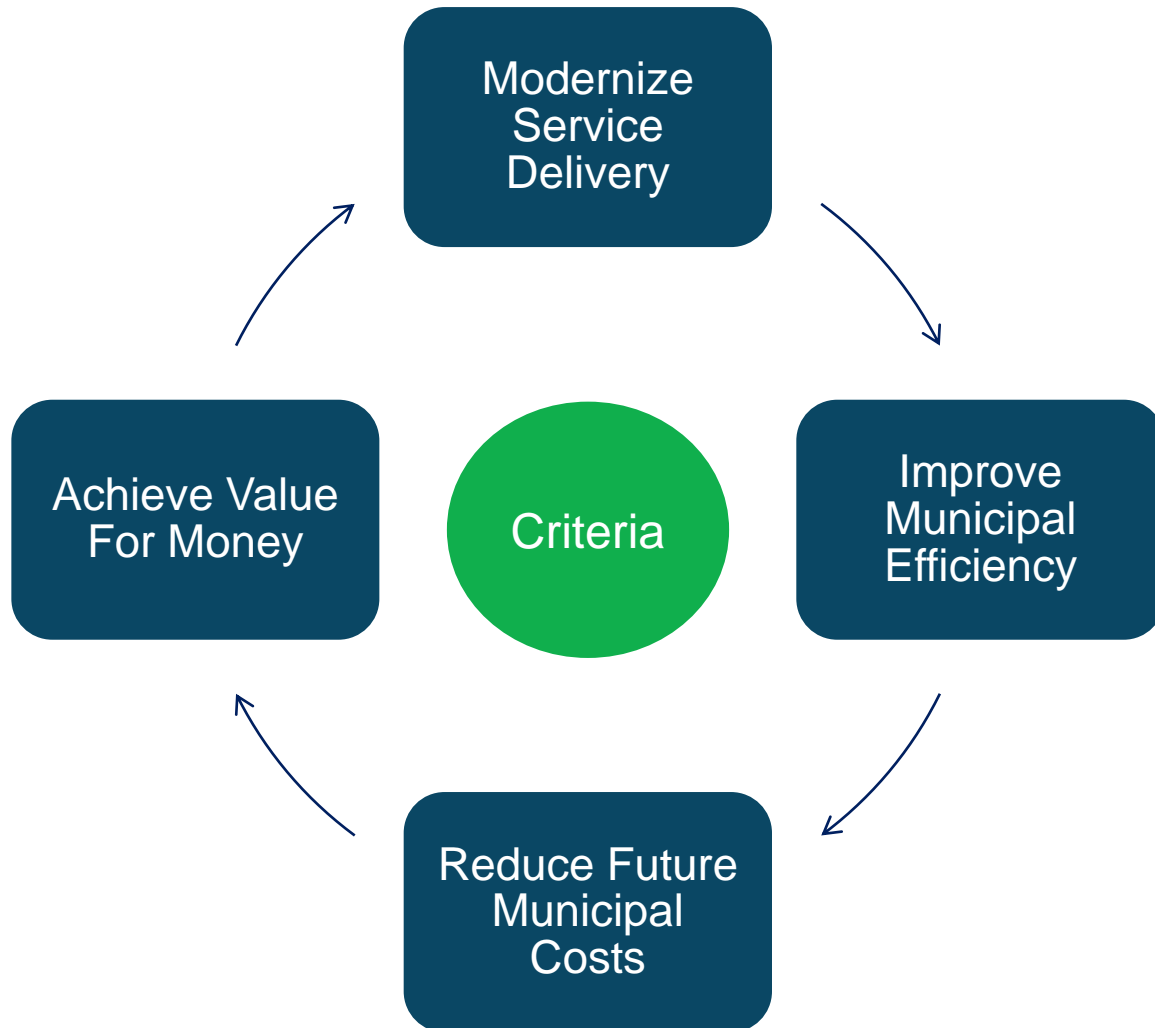
Provincial Modernization Funding

Province dedicated \$200 million to support the modernization efforts of 405 small and rural municipalities to improve local service delivery and efficiency.

Town of East Gwillimbury received \$725,000

- ✓ Development of shared services agreements

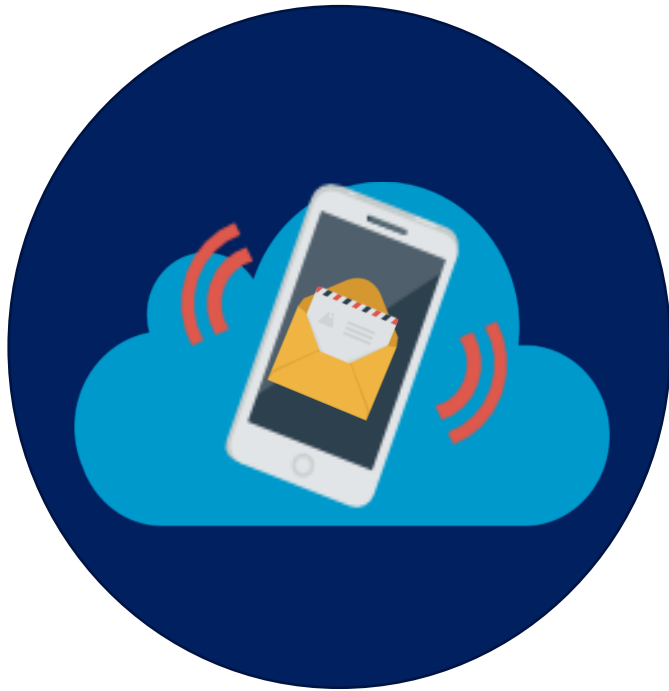

Next Level of Evaluation - EG Prioritization Criteria



Projects that are typically not eligible for grant and other funding programs

Resident Self-Serve Access via Online Portal



Focus on self-serve online services including:

- ✓ eBilling
- ✓ Online registration
- ✓ Online payments



- ✓ Redesign via new service provider
- ✓ Increase access to resident information & self-serve access
- ✓ Online submissions capabilities
- ✓ Utilize self-serve and GIS focus

Council Livestreaming Enhancement



- ✓ Enhance public experience in participating with the local government
- ✓ Implement modest technological improvements
- ✓ Upgrades enable viewers to fully engage with the contents

Phone System Automation & Upgrades



- ✓ Upgrades to phone server
- ✓ Voice recognition within automated attendant
- ✓ Upgraded reporting
- ✓ Ability to close Call Centre as required (Emergency Management Planning)

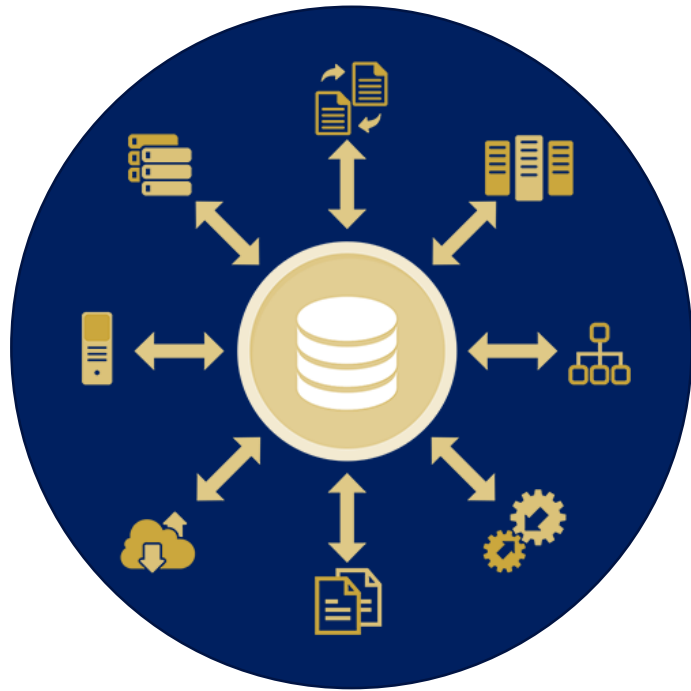

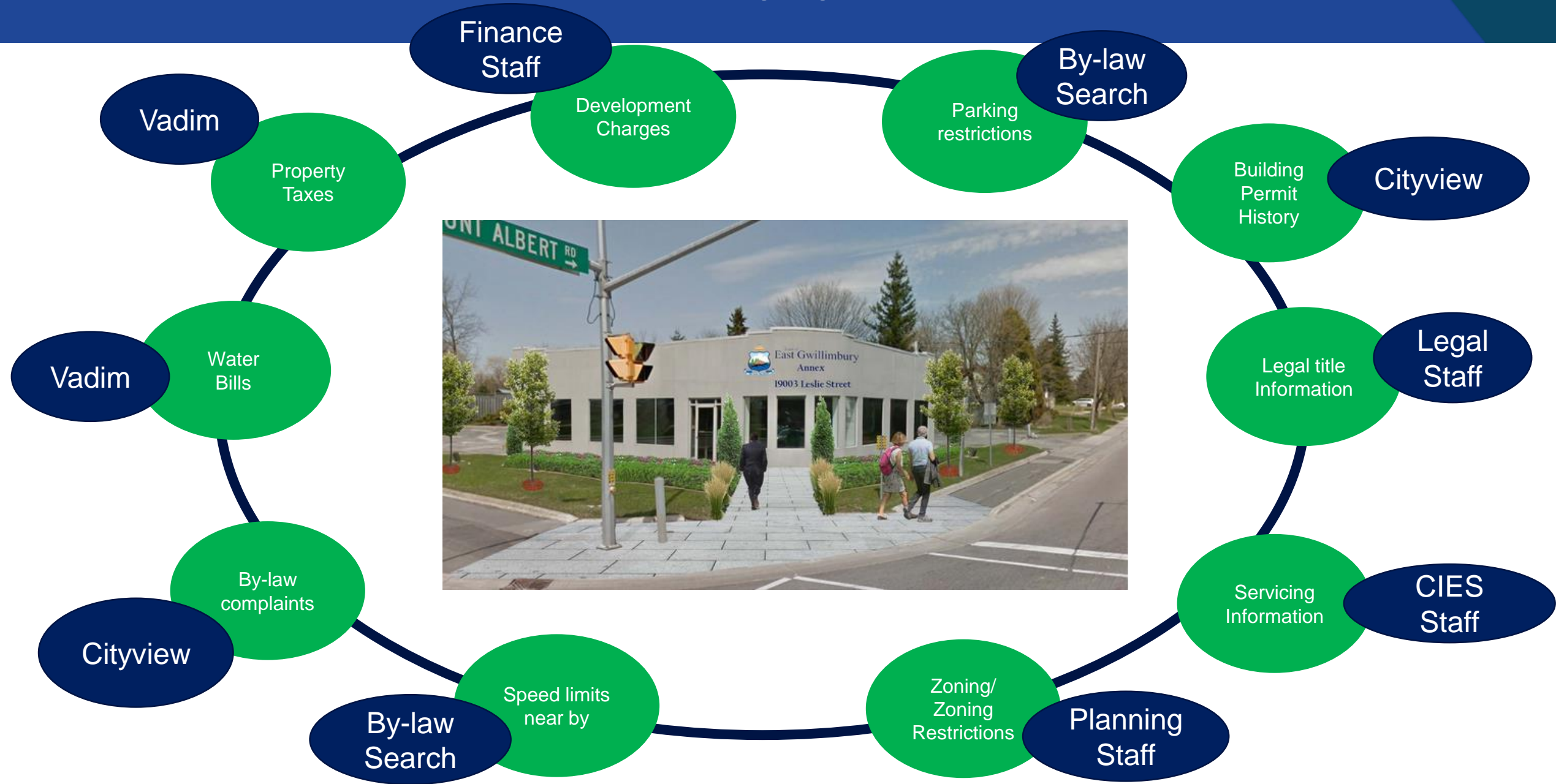

Digital Project Window



- ✓ Remotely monitor on site construction activity
- ✓ Provides "real time" virtual imaging of construction progress from any computer or mobile device
- ✓ Ensures that accountability is held with contractors
- ✓ Enhances project management strategies
- ✓ Provides progress updates in a timely fashion
