

## Senior (65+) or Low Income Disabled Water/Wastewater Deferral Program Application

The Town of East Gwillimbury offers eligible property owners a water/wastewater <u>deferral</u> program to assist homeowners with their water/wastewater bills. The amount that can be deferred is **50%** of the fixed/delivery charges. This amount is transferred to the tax account and acts as a lien against the property until the time in which the home is sold or a change of title occurs.

The program is only available to the eligible owners of the home that

- 1. receive water/wastewater bill directly from the Town of East Gwillimbury
- 2. are registered owners of the property
- 3. have owned the home for the full year in which they are applying for relief
- 4. are receiving one of the following government supplements
  - Guaranteed Income Supplement under the Old Age Security Act
  - Ontario Disability Support program
  - Ontario Works Assistance
